

## **Old Farm Rockport Cookout and Concert Set for August 10, Open to North Shore Brain Injured Community and Friends**

Old Farm Rockport, a Supportive Living, Inc. residential facility for survivors of brain injury is hosting a cookout and concert welcoming the local brain injured community on August 10. The Old Farm Inn at Halibut Point in Rockport started a new life in 2014 as a residential facility providing independent affordable housing for brain injury survivors. This year's concert features Ten Tumbo provided by the Rockport Music Education and Outreach Program.



Over 3 million people in the US suffer a brain injury each year and more than 6.4 million people live with a lifelong disability due to an acquired brain injury caused by falls and injuries or disease such as stroke and meningitis. The cookout and concert provide an opportunity for many North Shore residents who suffer from the permanent effects of brain injury to enjoy the beauty of the Halibut State Park area as well as socializing and enjoying the outdoor activities.
